

# Found Property



If you find property, it is your obligation to try to reunite it with its original owner, the following guidance will help you to report your find to the correct place.

Cumbria Police are able to accept found property which may be linked to a crime or contain personal data.


If you have found property in shops, pubs, public transport etc, hand this in to the Manager or member of staff for them to retain.

Item found	Report to:
Items containing personal data: Driving licences, passports, identification documents Credit / Debit / Store cards	The issuing authority, if you are unable to do this, hand into Cumbria Police who will forward to them.
Mobile phones	The service provider, if you are unable to do this, hand into Cumbria Police who will forward to them.
Handbag / Wallet / Purse / Jewellery	The owner, if they can be identified by any documents, If you can't identify the owner, hand to the police.
Keys	The owner, if you know who these belong too. If you can't identify the owner, please dispose securely.
Blue disabled parking badge	The local council, who is the issuing authority.
Pedal cycles	Your local district council.
