

Lost Property

Losing property can be distressing, the guidance below will help you report your lost items to the correct place and request replacements.



Cumbria Police are unable to take reports of lost property, to help you we have detailed below where you should report lost items.

If you have lost any property, retrace your steps contacting premises you have been to and check if they have had this handed in.

Item Lost	Report to:
Driving licences, passports, identification documents	The issuing authority. For more information about reporting a lost passport or driving licence visit www.gov.uk
Credit / Debit / Store cards	Your bank or credit card company.
Mobile phones	Your service provider.
Handbag / Wallet / Purse	The issuers for any documents or cards as above.
Blue disabled parking badge	The local council, who is the issuing authority.
Dogs	Your local district council, who may have picked your dog up as a stray. Consider calling local vets and refuge centres.
